PERMANENT EXPORT PERMIT

Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

for: the permanent export of a small sample (1 gram each) of bone, which consists of excavated material from sites at Taung (66), Kommetjie (97), Ladybrand (106), Darling (112), Ysterfontein (162), Oakhurst (205), Wyegang (331), Elands bay (373), Faroskop (385, 386, 390, 391, 394, 395, 396), Elands bay#2 (427), Elands bay#1 (428) and Cobern Street (53, 532, 539, 540) for DNA studies to determine the biological dynamics of Later Stone Age peoples in southern Africa,
from: Anatomical Osteology Collection, Department of Human Biology, University of Cape Town, Cape Town, Western Cape Province,
to: Dr R.A Knight,
of: Stanford University, Stanford, California, USA.

The following conditions apply:

1. It is understood that half the total sample will be analysed locally at the University of the Western Cape, Department of Molecular Biology.
2. Each artefact or specimen must be clearly marked with the accession number.
3. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the accession numbers, the name of the site, and the name and address of the permit holder or the custodian.
4. The samples must be kept for study purposes only. Any sample residues are to be returned.
5. Copies of any papers that may result from the export of the material must be lodged with SAHRA.
6. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
7. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit upon notice to the permit holder.
