TEMPORARY EXPORT PERMIT

Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

for: the temporary export of 30 *Pelorovis antiquus* tooth fragments from Upper Pleistocene MSA levels at Klasies Main site (accession number: SAM-AA 8778, loan number: 4367),
from: Klasies River Caves, Humansdorp, Eastern Cape Province,
to: Dr A Horsburgh c/o Dr Lisa Matisoo-Smith,
of: Department of Anthropology, University of Auckland, Human Sciences Building, 10 Symond St, Auckland, New Zealand.

The following conditions apply:

1. The objects or specimens must be clearly marked with accession numbers.
2. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the accession numbers, the name of the site, and the name and address of the permit holder or the custodian.
3. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Dr A Horsburgh without the consent of SAHRA.
4. The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before 7/1/05 at the expense of Dr A Horsburgh.
5. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before 1 July 2005.
6. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
7. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
8. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit upon notice to the permit holder.
