TEMPORARY EXPORT PERMIT

Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

to: Dr MA Raath,
of: the Bernard Price Institute for Palaeontological Research, University of the Witwatersrand, Private Bag 3, WITS 2050,
for: the temporary export (loan number: 300) of BP/1/6026 *Tetracynodon sp.* (partial skull, anterior presacrals, pectoral girdle, humeri) and BP/1/5898 *Erciolacerta* (skull and nearly complete post cranial skeleton), both from the early Triassic and from Barendskraal, Middelburg district,
from: the Bernard Price Institute for Palaeontological Research, University of the Witwatersrand, Gauteng province,
to: Dr S Modesto,
of: the Department of Behavioural & Life Sciences, University College of Cape Breton, Sydney, Nova Scotia, Canada.

The following conditions apply:

1. The objects or specimens must be clearly marked with accession numbers.
2. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the accession numbers, the name of the site, and the name and address of the permit holder or the custodian.
3. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Dr S Modesto without the consent of SAHRA.
4. The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before 1 August 2005 at the expense of Dr S Modesto.
5. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before 1 August 2005.
6. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
7. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
8. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit upon notice to the permit holder.
