**PERMANENT EXPORT PERMIT**

No. 80/04/08/044/52

Issued under Sections 32 and 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act, Act No. 25 of 1999. Permission is hereby given:

to: Ms R Pickering,  
of: the School of Geosciences, University of Witwatersrand, Private Bag 3, WITS, 2050, South Africa,  
for: the temporary export of the six samples of geological samples, five of which are from the main excavation site, which includes (a) a sample (c.40g) of flowstone which consists of very pure coarse-crystalline calcite as well as calcite pseudomorphs after aragonite; (b) pieces of thin calcite crust formed on clast within the breccia in the breccia cone; (c) fragments of calcite within "silty" layers of fine breccia cave fill overlying the debris cone; (d) (e) two hand specimens of "silty" fine breccia cave fill and (f) a sample of flowstones overlying the deposits of the lower cave containing debris cone, the latter is which is to be sampled 10m N of main excavation,  
from: Drimolen, Krugersdorp, Gauteng Province,  
to: Professor J.D Kramers,  
of: Institute of Geological Sciences, University of Berne, Erlachstrasse, Berne, 3012, Switzerland,  
for: testing of samples using Uranium-lead dating and palaeomagnetic studies.

The following conditions apply:

1. The objects or specimens must be clearly marked with accession numbers.
2. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the accession numbers, the name of the site, and the name and address of the permit holder or the custodian.
3. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Prof J.D Kramers without the consent of SAHRA.
4. The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before 1 September 2005 at the expense of Prof J.D Kramers.
5. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before 1 September 2005.
6. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
7. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
8. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit upon notice to the permit holder.

This permit is valid until 1 September 2005.
