4. The samples must be kept for study purposes only and may not be sold or exchanged.
5. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Prof. Susan Pfeiffer and Prof. Christopher Ramsay without the consent of SAHRA.
6. A draft report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before the end of July 2015.
7. Copies of any papers that may result from the export of the material must be lodged with SAHRA.
8. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
9. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
