This permit is issued to Prof. Michael Chazan for the temporary export of 28 sediment samples, 1 rock fragment, 1 micro fauna specimen and 20 micro-debitage lithic specimens. All material will be exported to Prof. Franseca Bernaof the Geoarchaeology Lab of Simon Fraser University, Burnaby, Canada for soil micromorphology, infrared spectroscopy, micro-spectroscopy, and magnetic susceptibility (MagSus) analyses.

7. Copies of any papers that may result from the export of the material must be lodged with SAHRA. A report must be submitted to SAHRA on or before 30 September 2018.
8. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
9. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
