Object: UP-Skeleton Samples for DNA and C14
To: Mattias Jakobsson

This permit is issued to Prof Maryna Steyn (University of Witwaterand - Dept of Anatomical Sciences) in collaboration with Prof. Mattias Jakobsson to sample and export twelve (12) specimens of human skeletal remains for aDNA analysis and radiocarbon dating. The aDNA analysis will be done at the Jakobsson Laboratory (Uppsala) and the radiocarbon dating will be done at the Beta Dating Laboratory, Oxford.

Conditions:

1. The objects or specimens must be clearly marked with accession numbers.
2. The material must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the accession numbers, the name of the site, and the name and address of the permit holder or the Department of Anatomy, University of Pretoria.
3. The material will be hand carried by one of the researchers. Please note that the name of individual responsible for transporting the material must be furnished to SAHRA. It is noted that the samples will be couriered to Beta Analytic subsequent to the aDNA analysis.
4. The samples must be kept for study purposes only, and may not be sold or exchanged.
5. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Prof. Mattias Jakobsson without the consent of SAHRA.
6. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of any remaining material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before 31 December 2019.
7. Copies of any papers that may result from the export of the material must be lodged with SAHRA. A report must be submitted to SAHRA on or before 31 December 2019.
8. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
9. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
