This permit is issued to Mr Frans Roodt to excavate a previously ploughed field with the aid of a mechanical excavator to uncover intact archaeological material at the Lwala Mine, Limpopo Province. It is noted that 30cm of topsoil will be removed over an area 9 100 m² with a mechanical excavator. It also noted test pits will be done at selected features to collect samples for dating and analysis.

Conditions:

1. If the permit holder is not to be present on the site at all times then the heritage authority must be provided with the names and qualifications of the authorised representatives.
2. Adequate recording methods as specified in the Regulations and Guidelines pertaining to the National Heritage Resources Act must be employed. Note that the position of all excavations and objects collected must be marked on a plan of site.
3. A standard site record form must be lodged with the Polokwane Museum.
4. All archaeological material collected and excavated, as well as field notes and records, will be curated by the Polokwane Museum.
5. A final report is due on or before 30 June 2020. The report must be submitted to apmpermitreports@sahra.org.za
6. Reprints of all published papers or copies of theses and/or reports resulting from this work must be lodged with the heritage authority.
7. If a published report has not appeared within three years of the lapsing of this permit, the report required in terms of the permit will be made available to researchers on request.
8. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
9. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to fill in excavations and protect sites during and after excavation to the satisfaction of the heritage authority and the landowner.
10. The heritage authority shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties
