- 8. A final report on the results of the mitigation must be submitted to the heritage authority issuing this permit before 31 August 2024, and must be submitted to the case.
- 9. Reprints of all published papers or copies of theses and/or reports resulting from this work must be lodged with the heritage authority.
- 10. If a published report has not appeared within three years of the lapsing of this permit, the report
