This permit is issued to Ms Kawaguchi of Voice Japan for the filming within the boundaries of the National Heritage Site of Sterkfontein Cave.

Conditions:

1. SAHRA has noted the names of crew on site during filming to be as follows: Yutaka Moriyama, Tomami Ino, Mitsuru Kobayashi, Ruiko Kawaguchi.
2. SAHRA understand that Ms Marshall will assist with monitoring. Such monitoring should take place at all times when your crew is on site.
3. Ms Marshall must be consulted prior to activities commencing on site to advise the crew on any archaeologically sensitive areas which must be avoided.
4. The amount of traffic, i.e. numbers of people on site, should be minimized as much as possible to avoid excessive disturbance of the site.
5. A report on activities related to the permit must be submitted to SAHRA before the end of October 2015. SAHRA reserves the right to withhold further permits if a report is not received or is not satisfactory.
6. Copies of reports/film resulting from this work must be lodged with SAHRA.
7. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and the applicant is responsible for ensuring that he or she has an understanding with the landowner concerning: the number of visitors and workers; speed limits on access roads; possible prohibitions on off-road driving; size, type and number of vehicles permitted; possible prohibitions on trespassing beyond the site; disturbing fauna, flora or substrate; appropriate hours of working on the site; use of electricity and water. Conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
8. The applicant shall be responsible for the activities and impacts of all colleagues and employees under his or her supervision and for their compliance with the terms of the permit.
9. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to protect sites during and after filming to the satisfaction of SAHRA and the landowner.
10. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
11. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit upon notice to the permit holder.
