Ackerman for the sampling and export of 70 samples of Later Stone Age and Late Pleistocene Khoesan dental calculus for analysis to be carried out the Centre for Geogenetics at the University of Copenhagen.

Conditions:

The specimens must be clearly marked with accession numbers.

5. Samples not used for analysis must be returned to South Africa.
6. A report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before the end of January 2016.
7. Copies of any papers that may result from the export of the material must be lodged with SAHRA.
8. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
9. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
