

2. The material must be hand carried or sent via a reputable professional courier service. SAHRA understands that the six specimens will be hand carried to Europe by Dr Wurz.
3. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Prof. Mattias Jakobsson without the consent of SAHRA.
4. The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before the end of August 2015 at the expense of Prof. Mattias Jakobsson.
5. SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before the end of August 2015.
6. Copies of all papers or publications resulting from this permit must be lodged with SAHRA.
7. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
8. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
