The specimen will be hand carried both to and from the school of Geography, Earth and Environmental Sciences University of Birmingham.

The specimen will be hand carried to and from Berlin for micro-CT scanning analyses.

The specimen must be clearly marked with accession numbers.

The specimen must be carefully packed and all packaging must be clearly marked with the accession number, the name of the site, and the name and address of the permit holder or the School of Geography, Earth and Environmental Sciences University of Birmingham.

The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than to Dr Richard J. Butler without the consent of SAHRA.

The material shall be returned to South Africa on or before the 30th of November 2014 at the expense of Dr Richard J. Butler.

SAHRA must be notified in writing of the return of the material, and a report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA on or before the 30th of November 2014.
