- 8. The permit holder shall be responsible for the activities and impacts of all colleagues and employees under his supervision and for their compliance with the terms of the permit.
- 9. It is the responsibility of Mr Werner to ensure that any other permits requested by the Management Authority of the Cradle of Humankind World Heritage Site is received before filming commences.
- 10. It is the responsibility of Mr Werner to protect sites during and after filming and to the satisfaction of SAHRA and the landowner.
