Site: Pretoria City Centre (Operation Reclaim)

This permit is for the excavation and collection of archaeological material uncovered during the trenching for Operation Reclaim in Tshwane. It is expected that tram rails, old water furrows and kerbstones be concealed beneath.

Conditions:

1. If Dr van Vollenhoven is not to be present on the site at all times then the heritage authority must be provided with the names and qualifications of the authorised representatives.
2. Adequate recording methods as specified in the Regulations and Guidelines pertaining to the National Heritage Resources Act must be employed. Note that the position of all excavations and all objects collected must be marked on a plan of site.
3. A standard site record form must be lodged with the Ditsong Museum.
4. All archaeological material collected and excavated, as well as field notes and records, will be curated by the Ditsong Museum.
5. A progress report on the results of the excavations and analyses must be submitted to SAHRA by the end of December 2014. A final report is due by the end of December 2015.
6. Reprints of all published papers or copies of reports resulting from this work must be lodged with SAHRA.
7. If a published report has not appeared within three years of the lapsing of this permit, the report required in terms of the permit will be made available to researchers on request.
8. It is the responsibility of Dr van Vollenhoven to protect sites during and after the archaeological excavation to the satisfaction of the heritage authority and the landowner.
9. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
10. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
