

This permit is issued to Dr Morris and Dr Horwitz for the permanent export of powdered samples from 142 faunal teeth and two charcoal samples for isotopic analyses and radiocarbon dating.

5. The material may not be loaned to any person or institution other than Dr Horwitz and Ms Ecker at the Research Laboratory for Archaeology and History of Art at the University of Oxford without the consent of SAHRA.
6. A report on the activities undertaken in terms of this permit must be lodged with SAHRA before the end of September 2015.
7. Copies of any papers that may result from the export of the material must be lodged with SAHRA.
8. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
9. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
