# **PERMIT: Filming**

Conditions:

- SAHRA has noted that crew on site will be composed by a Director, Mr Graham Townsley; two Directors of Photography, one of whom will be the chief DP Mr Willem van de Heever; an additional camera person and "fixer", Ms Rachelle Keeling; a sound person and possibly a grip.
- Either Prof. Berger or a senior scientist, appointed by Prof. Berger himself, will be on site at all times during filming.

Conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
- The permit holder shall be responsible for the activities and impacts of all colleagues and employees under his supervision and for their compliance with the terms of the permit.
- It is the responsibility of the permit holder to protect sites during and after filming to the satisfaction of SAHRA and the landowner.
