
A Permit is hereby issued to **Richards Bay Minerals** of Richards Bay, 3900, Kwa-Zulu Natal in accordance with the application received on 16 August 2017.

Purpose: Post survey and mitigation destruction

Conditions: *This permit is issued subject to the following conditions:-*

- 1 **The permit is limited to the area that requires mining activities as per the RBM Zulti North Cultural Heritage Management Plan 2014-2016. Work outside this area will require additional permits.**
- 2 If the permit holder is not to be present on the site at all times then the heritage authority must be provided with the names and qualifications of the authorised representatives.
- 3 Adequate recording methods as specified in the Regulations and Guidelines pertaining to the National Heritage Resources Act must be employed. Note that the position of all excavations and objects collected must be marked on a plan of site.
- 4 All archaeological material collected and excavated, as well as field notes and records, will be curated by the Amafa.
- 5 An annual progress report on the results of the excavations and analyses must be submitted to the heritage authority issuing this permit on 31/01/2015 and 31/01/2016, and a final report is due on or before 31/01/2017.
- 6 Reprints of all published papers or copies of theses and/or reports resulting from this work must be lodged with the heritage authority.
- 7 If a published report has not appeared within three years of the lapsing of this permit, the report required in terms of the permit will be made available to researchers on request.
- 8 It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
- 9 It is the responsibility of the permit holder to fill in excavations and protect sites during and after excavation to the satisfaction of the heritage authority and the landowner.
- 10 The heritage authority shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 11 The heritage authority reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
- 11.1 **FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE CONDITIONS WILL RENDER ANY ACTIVITY CONDUCTED UNLAWFUL, AND AMAFA-AKWAZULU NATALI RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CANCEL THIS PERMIT AND TO INSTITUTE CRIMINAL AND/OR CIVIL ACTION AGAINST THE PERSON/S RESPONSIBLE.**
- 11.2 *The issuing of this permit does not exempt the Applicant from compliance with any other law, where applicable.*

This permit is valid until 31 October 2020 **AND IS NOT TRANSFERABLE.**
