## PERMIT: Collection, Excavation

In terms of section 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999)

**For: Collection of marine fossil and sediments from the palaeo-shoreline of the Northern Cape for palaeoenvironmental studies.**

Conditions:

1. If the permit holder is not to be present on the site at all times then SAHRA must be provided with the names and qualifications of the authorised representatives.
2. Adequate recording methods as specified in the Regulations and Guidelines pertaining to the National Heritage Resources Act must be employed. Note that the position of all objects collected must be marked on a map.
3. A standard site record form must be lodged with the Iziko South African Museum.
4. All fossils collected, which are considered as significant by the Iziko Museum, as well as field notes and records, will be curated by the Iziko South African Museum.
5. A report on the specimens recovered and their origin must be submitted to the heritage authority annually on or before the 1st of July for the duration of the permit.
6. Reprints of all published papers or copies of theses and/or reports resulting from this work must be lodged with the heritage authority.
7. If a published report has not appeared within three years of the lapsing of this permit, the report required in terms of the permit will be made available to researchers on request.
8. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
9. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to protect sites during and after collection to the satisfaction of SAHRA and the landowner.
10. SAHRA shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
11. SAHRA reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
12. This permit is subject to a general appeal and may be suspended should an appeal against the decisions be received by SAHRA within 14 days from the date of the permit. SAHRA may not be held


