In terms of Section 35(4) of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999)

Permit Holder: Prof. Anton van Vollenhoven

Site: Steinaecker's Horse Gomondwane site (Steinaecker's Horse Gomondwane Site)

This permit is issued to Prof. Anton van Vollenhoven to undertake archaeological excavations at the Steinaecker's Horse Gomondwane Site, Kruger National Park.

Conditions:

1. If Prof. van Vollenhoven is not to be present on the site at all times then SAHRA must be provided with the names and qualifications of the authorised representatives.
2. Adequate recording methods as specified in the Regulations and Guidelines pertaining to the National Heritage Resources Act must be employed. Note that the position of all excavations and objects collected must be marked on a plan of site.
3. A standard site record form must be lodged with the Ditsong National Museum of Cultural History.
4. All archaeological material collected and excavated, as well as field notes and records, will be curated by the Ditsong National Museum of Cultural History.
5. An annual progress report on the results of the excavations and analyses must be submitted to SAHRA by the end of June 2019, June 2020 and December 2021. A final report is due by the end of June 2022. Please note that this report must explain the relationship between these findings and the findings of previous excavation undertaken in the Kruger National Park as part of the same project on the Steinaecker's Horse unit.
6. Reprints of all published papers or copies of theses and/or reports resulting from this work must be lodged with SAHRA
7. If a published report has not appeared within three years of the lapsing of this permit, the report required in terms of the permit will be made available to researchers on request.
8. It is the responsibility of Dr van Vollenhoven to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
9. It is the responsibility of Dr van Vollenhoven to fill in excavations and protect sites during and after
