This permit is issued to Dr Aurore Val (Evolutionary Studies Institute, WITS) and Dr Guillaume Porraz (CNRS and Ditsong Museum) to excavate the archaeological site of Heuningneskrans, located in the Limpopo Province of South Africa. It is noted that the excavated material will be curated at the McGregor Museum, Kimberley where the historical collection is housed.

Conditions:

1. SAHRA must be furnished with the names of all senior researchers affiliated to the project in the event that the principal permit holders are not able to supervise any aspects of the filed work.
2. Please note that any changes/amendments to the research agenda as indicated in page 23 and page 24 of the detailed research proposal submitted as motivation must be provided to SAHRA as soon as possible.
3. Adequate recording methods as specified in the Regulations and Guidelines pertaining to the National Heritage Resources Act must be employed. Note that the position of all excavations and objects collected must be marked on a plan of site.
4. A standard site record form must be lodged with the McGregor Museum.
5. A detailed site recording must be completed on the South African Heritage Resources Information System, SAHRIS.
6. All archaeological material collected and excavated, as well as field notes and records, will be curated by the McGregor Museum.
7. An annual progress report on the results of the excavations and analyses must be submitted to the heritage authority issuing this permit on 31 December 2019 and 31 December 2020, and a final report is due on or before 31 December 2021.
8. Reprints of all published papers or copies of theses and/or reports resulting from this work must be lodged with the heritage authority.
9. If a published report has not appeared within three years of the lapsing of this permit, the report
