- 3. A standard site record form must be lodged with the Iziko: South African Museum.
- All material collected and excavated, as well as field notes and records, will be curated by the University of Cape Town following their requirements for submission of archaeological materials.
- 5. A final report **MUST** be submitted to HWC on or before 01 November 2011. An extension to this permit can be granted on submission of a progress report (if work was initiated) and a letter stating reasons for the extension. HWC reserves the right to withhold further permits if progress is not deemed satisfactory.
- 6. Reprints of all published papers, or copies of theses or reports resulting from this work must be lodged with HWC.
- If a published report has not appeared within three years of the lapsing of this permit, the report required in terms of the permit will be made available to researchers on request.
- 8. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to obtain permission from the landowner for each visit, and conditions of access imposed by the landowner must be observed.
- 9. HWC shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities in connection with this permit.
- 11. HWC reserves the right to cancel this permit by notice to the permit holder.
