

Preliminary site description: Sholtzenhof 01

The stone walled house is situated approximately 60 metres west from a small river/stream. The rectilinear kraals are approximately 95 metres away from the house to the north-west. The irregular kraal is approximately 70 metres from the house to the north. The smaller dwelling sits in between the house and the domestic dump.

The artefacts suggest that this site was home to both indigenous peoples and Europeans. Whether they were contemporaneous is yet to be established.

Structures:

Three kraals, two are rectilinear and one is an irregular circle

One stone walled house

One smaller dwelling

Features:

Domestic dump

Artefacts:

Lithics (silcrete & quartzite)

Refined earthenware (Delft, Mocha, sponge ware, stone ware)

Ostrich eggshell

Course earthenware
