DESCRIPTION: Single storey veranda house. Hipped corrugated iron roof. Stone walls, some walls plastered. Timber frame sash windows, as well as iron frame windows with security bars. Front veranda with a cement step walkway leading up to it. Timber posts with Edwardian style brackets are enclosed with stone, rounded, and covering ¾ of the post to the bottom. Stone veranda floor.

CONSTRUCTION: Stone and corrugated iron.

ALTERATIONS (with dates): Enclosed back-veranda, with painted and plastered walls. Steel-frame windows on the Eastern facing wall of the house. Solar panel on the roof (circa 2005). The veranda is extended 1 metre forward (circa 2005). Stones placed in the front, around the gardening area.
