B. 8: SHORT DESCRIPTION OF SITE:

LATE IRON AGE STONE WALL (POORLY DEFINED)

The Late Iron Age stone wall is situated in the eastern section of Area 1a (LB/3), and is poorly defined and currently level with the surface. It was built with small stones. No surface material was observed. It is severely disturbed by vegetation and by activity from the nearby recent settlements. The identification of the LIA stone wall was also confirmed by Dr. J. Pistorius in his report of February 2005, A Phase 1 HIA study for the proposed New Burgersfort ext 30 Residential, and the Burgersfort ext 31 industrial development projects near Burgersfort.

It is at an elevation of 713m and the GPS co-ordinates are as follows: $$24^{\circ} 39' 59.5" / E30^{\circ} 13' 27.5"$

The area that was assessed during the Phase 1 study in August 2009, revealed no other Late Iron Age features in the vicinity of the stone wall.
