In considering the matter, the committee was pleased to note the effort which you and your client have taken in ensuring the refurbisment of the building.


The committee approved the proposed work on the front facade as detailed in your drawings E474 DET A and DET B.

FRONT OF CARD: Old Mutual's restoration of the Muirhead & Gowie building makes it a fitting focal point for the Church Square shop facades, which together form one of the finest examples of late 19th and early 20th century commercial frontage in the Southern Hemisphere. This ornate Edwardian edifice was designed by Hubert Walker in 1906 and erected in 1907 after a fire had destroyed the previous premises dating back to 1886. Present project architect, Mr Martin Goldswain, a great-great-grandson of 1820 Settler Jeremiah Goldswain, made extensive use of original working drawings like the one reproduced here.


